Grades for 4th Quarter- HIGH SCHOOL only

Official Grade Announcement for HIGH-SCHOOL:

HS Grading Policy for Remote Learning

Final Grade

Students will receive either a **Pass (PC19)**, **Withdraw (WC19)**, or **Numeric Grade** for each course.

Seniors passing as of March 13th have passed for the year.

Students have the opportunity to improve their grade through remote learning.

Grading Assessment Method

All grades will be **informal**.

All grades will reflect **Mastery** = 90+, **Partial Mastery** = 80-89, **Non-Mastery** (or no submission) = **EXEMPT**

There will be no formal grades or final exams.

Remote Learning Timeline

(March 13th-26th) Students were given the opportunity to make-up Q3 work that they did not have an opportunity to submit before to the end of quarter.

(April 6th-30th) Assignments done during April 6th-30th will be documented as mastered, partially/mastered, non-mastery, or exempt. These assignments will be entered into PowerSchool as informal grades.

(May 1st-29th) Teachers will assess and provide feedback on a minimum of one, and a maximum of two assignments, weekly to determine students' improvement. Assignments done during March 1st-29th will be documented as mastered, partially/mastered, or non-mastery. These assignments will be entered into PowerSchool as informal grades. Students who do not do assignments in May will receive a 59 minimum. **Incomplete assignments are NOT EXEMPT during this time period.**

What does it *REALLY* mean for this class:

You need to choose one of the 3 options.*** will be a question on End of Year Google Form for my classes***

WC19 = withdrawn from class- you won't get credit, and won't impact your GPA

- So far no-one in my classes really qualify for this option, so don't worry about it.

PC19= you get credit for the class but won't impact your GPA

Numeric Grade= you get credit for the class and it will count towards your GPA

- Based on the scores for your Booklet and Final Assignments in Canvas/PowerSchool.
- Need to do the work anyway so you're set up to be more successful in the Fall.
- Best option overall if you can get them turned in the work and earn 16+/20 on each assignment.

PROs/CON's for PC19/Numeric Grade

- GPA can affect what schools you can apply to (both college and trade schools), what scholarships and grants you can apply for, and class ranking for graduation (Valedictorian, Salutatorian, Diploma's of merit, Letters, etc. basically fun bragging rights, etc).
- **Numeric grades can help raise or lower your GPA.** Basically you want to choose which one will help yourself out the most. Overall work from my class is simple, not super time consuming, and everyone could easily get an A on it if you really tried and could help offset some lower grades from other classes.
- You have until the beginning of Next school year (mid August to make up your mind and improve scores)
- Only reason to really take the PC19 is if you are really worried about lowering your GPA.

Look for a **Canvas Assignment that will ask you for your preference over the next week or so**

Grades for 4th Quarter- MIDDLE SCHOOL only

- For this quarter you will get one of the 2 options
- **WC10** = you won't get credit for the class, and won't impact your GPA
 - So far no-one in my classes really qualify for this option, so don't worry about it, but may want to know for your other classes.
- **PC19**= you get credit for the class and won't impact your GPA
 - Just need to make sure you get all your Booklet Assignments turned in on Canvas with scores of 10+/20.
 - If you're missing any of them or need to re-upload images you can still do that through the end of the quarter. I'm still taking everything for full credit and will even regrade stuff if you want too.
- No letter/numerical grade for this quarter (at least that's how I currently understand it as of May 17th).

#3 Common Canvas Issues

Canvas Problems

- **What scores mean...**
 - It's feedback!
 - Look at Rubrics- they explain points earned and suggest what you need to work on improving.
 - Read Comments if you have them! Extra feedback, advice, instructions, and any other info you or I might need.
- **Broken Links**
 - Links needed for all Canvas work is on the class websites
 - UniverseOfCreativity.net
 - CreativeSchmit.com (building a new site for next year;-)
 - I've found a way to check them now- you don't need to message me about them anymore.
 - I'm not fixing any past broken links at this point
- **Problems Uploading Files to Canvas**
 - **Must be a PDF or JPG ONLY**
 - Simple Fix: print file as a pdf instead of selecting a printer you select "print to pdf". Basically all software has this feature even your camera-phones!
 - Google "how to print ___(file type)___ as a pdf"
 - Example "How to print HITC file as a pdf on my phone"
 - **File might be too big (try to keep under 2 M)**
 - **TAKE TIME TO WAIT FOR files TO UPLOAD-** it doesn't tell you it's uploaded or not and looks like it's instantaneously but it's not. You just have to wait for at least 30 seconds- seriously count it out. Also there is a limit to file size even though it doesn't tell you.
 - Think about how long it usually takes a canvas page to load- it's going to take about the same time for files to upload.
 - If it's still showing error messages: Google "how to change file size for PDF or JPG" for help.

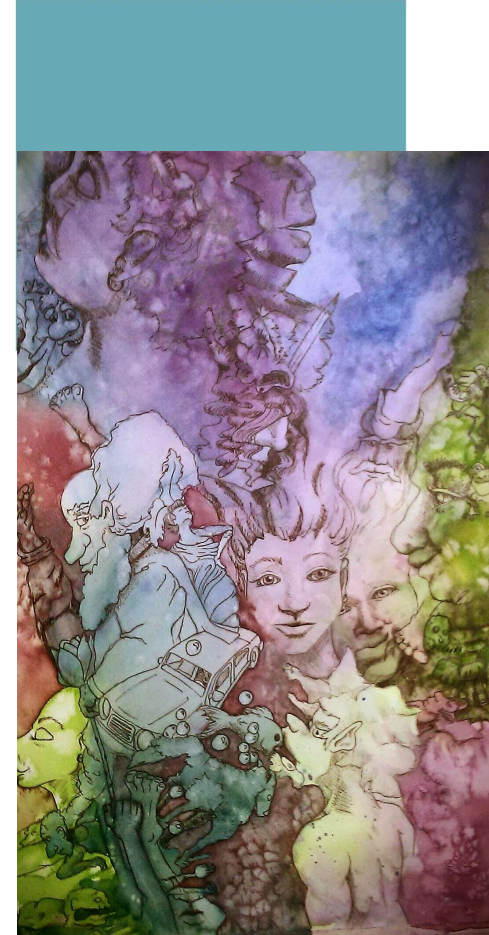
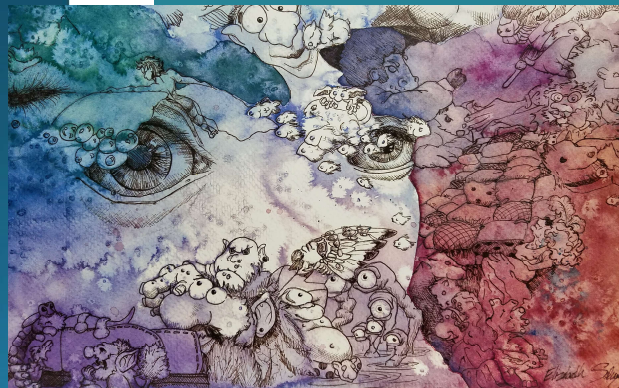

Canvas Assignments

3. If you have questions or are really far behind message me asap!

Common Canvas Issues/Fixes

1. Only submit PDF or JPG files
2. All software has "Print file as PDF" option (including camera-phones!) instead of selecting a real printer.
3. When uploading, wait for Assignments to upload before clicking "Final Submit" button. If you still get errors- file is too big.
4. Google "how to.... in Canvas" when you get stuck or don't know how to do some thing in Canvas.

General End of Year Stuff

1. Look for Google Form from me.
2. Check Canvas and Class website for announcements
3. **School is still working out details** but will likely have something set up where you at least drop off any school property (Chromebooks, Books, Art supplies you checked out from me, etc.) and pick up anything you left at school.
